Bible Point - Our Safe Shelter

Overview

We do not have children's chapel this week!! We will all be together in that Main Service with our families this week!

We will continue to study Jesus' 'model of prayer' He taught the disciples. For the last 2 weeks we have learned about 'debt'...that means how much is owed. Our sin is a huge debt against God because He is holy and will not accept sin in His presence. God gave us Jesus to pay our debt of sin and only He can do that...Jesus Christ alone is accepted by God for paying for our sin debt! If we truly love Him for that and are truly amazed by that, we will become more forgiving of others! This is the awesome part of Christianity...even though I was a sinner, Jesus took my punishment!

That kids is amazing love!! The truth is we will never be able to pay Him back...the only thing we must do is trust Him, obey Him, and tell the world about Him! As long as we live, we will need God's strength and His protection. The next part of the prayer model asks God to "lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.."

This is a very important part of praying because it teaches that God is not only our deliverer from the debt of sin, but He is also our protector! Every one of us wants to be kept safe from harm and danger. There are many different types of 'danger' Christians can experience...some of the worst ones are those that cause us to doubt, distrust, and take our attention off of God and His Word.

This week in worship, we are going to study about this part of the prayer and learn what we really need protection from and what we need strength to do.
