



POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR CHILDREN'S CHAPEL

Children's chapel is where our Sunday morning Children's Sermon takes place.

- Your child will sit with you during the first portion of the morning worship service. This is our policy because we believe in worshipping as a family. We do however understand a child's lack of ability to understand some of the deeper truths of scripture.
- Your child will be instructed by the music minister to leave just before the sermon begins. (a group of adults will direct the children where to go)
- Children's Chapel is a place where kids ...
 - Learn about missions by watching a *Kids on Mission* video.
 - Split into discussion teams in order to ask questions about the video and to get ready for the sermon.
 - Worship God by listening to the children's sermon which is prepared in conjunction with the Pastor's sermon so that you and your child will be learning about the same scripture.
 - The sermon consists of...
 - the same scripture you are learning only in a way that is understandable for children
 - visual teaching methods
 - discussion group dynamics
- There is available online a weekly overview of the children's sermon with preparation ideas and follow-up

activities to help ensure your child is “getting” the material covered.
